COST Programme


- COST has been established in 1971
- In September 2013 COST has been transformed to an international non-profit organisation named COST
 Association
- Management, Administration, and Implementation are consolidated in a single structure what ensures an intergovernmental and pan-European dimension.

COST goals

- Being a precursor of an advanced interdisciplinary research, COST provides a basis for European Research Area creation.
- COST is focused on so called precompetitive research, on bridging fundamental research to new technology development.
- COST foresees and complements the European Framework Programmes.
- COST ensures high mobility of European researchers and supports the research quality.


COST – Poland participation

- The first graph below shows the percentage of national Action participations with respect to the total number of Actions running at any time of the year (shown in brackets).




Polish participation in COST

Polish participation in networking activities as Meetings, Short Term Scientific Missions, Training Schools


The graph below shows the total number of reimbursed participants from national institutions in COST Action networking activities (meetings, Short Term Scientific Missions, Training Schools).




Budget


