# TU1208 GPR Association objective

(from the Statutes)

- TU1208 GPR Association was created as a **follow-up of COST Action TU1208** “Civil engineering applications of Ground Penetrating Radar,” to keep the scientific network alive and cohesive, to continue the excellent work that has been done in the framework of the Action, and to further support cooperation between Universities, research institutes, private companies and public agencies active in the GPR field.
- TU1208 GPR Association **inherited the same primary objective of the COST Action TU108**: Exchange and increase scientific-technical knowledge and experience of GPR techniques, while promoting the effective use of this safe and non-destructive technique.
